To: All Teaching Faculty

Objective

In order to promote an environment of continuous faculty development and research at ISME, the following incentive scheme will be applicable as of 1st July 2023. This incentive scheme can be modified / cancelled with immediate effect at any point of time in the future if it is not found to be working well in practice. The current expectation on teaching, administrative activities, student support, clubs, event organization etc. continues to remain the same.

Note: A year will be an academic year from 1st July to 30th June

Guidelines

1. Faculty is encouraged to publish beyond the guidelines. However, the incentive system will be based on the guidelines in order to focus on quality of content over quantity and in order to also ensure that the performance on other regular expectations is not compromised.

Conference Presentation	Twice in a year
Paper publication in Scopus or ABDC or Web of Science	Minimum two in a year
Guiding students to present in conference or publish in peer-reviewed/ UGC approved journals	Minimum 3 students per year

2. Work from home on Saturdays

To avail work from home on Saturdays, faculty members are expected to publish blogs.

Requirements:

- Minimum of 6 blogs and maximum of 12 blogs in an academic year.
- Must publish atleast three blogs in the cycle of July- December to avail work from home in the subsequent January- June cycle.
- Must publish atleast three blogs in the cycle of January-June to avail work from home in the subsequent July- December cycle.
- For new joiners:
 - New joiners must work from office on the first four Saturdays, from the date of joining

- Must publish one blog within 4 weeks of joining to avail the work from home on Saturdays in the current academic cycle. For example, if you joined on 1st August 2023, then you must publish one blog within 4 weeks of joining, to avail WFH on Saturdays from September 2023 to December 2023.
- After publishing the first blog within 4 weeks of joining, new joiners must mail to Director, Dean, Reporting Manager, Head Research, Head Infrastructure, Head IT Systems that they have read the policy and are eligible to avail the WFH on Saturdays. Further, they will fulfil the required number of blogs to avail WFH on Saturdays in the academic cycle.

Incentive

The incentive scheme is applicable only if faculty members give proper affiliation with **International School of Management Excellence, Bangalore**. Complete details of the conference / publication need to be saved in the myISME shared documents in the individual faculty folder (\\MYISME\isme\Faculty and Staff Development\Current Faculty and Staff).

Details as per the checklist and the myISME link should be provided to the Research Coordinator before being considered for incentive.
